Please Note: *We will work with you as much as possible to meet the objectives of your group. We can occasionally arrange special meetings or activities focused on your specific interests. However, we do not build customized tours from scratch. All our tours are based on Food First's relationships on the ground, which have been built up over many years, and must reflect our organization's mission.*

Steps for Requesting a Private Food Sovereignty Tour:

1. Meet with your school, organization, professional association, or group to discuss the destination and objective of your Tour. Then set some tentative trip dates, trip length, program ideas and accommodation preferences.
2. Complete the application and assign a point person who will work directly with our Food Sovereignty Tours Coordinator. This person helps facilitate communication between Food First and your group.
3. Call us with your Visa or Mastercard to pay the \$1,000 setup fee or write a check for this amount made out to Food First. This set up fee serves as the deposits for 5 passengers and will be transferred to your tour cost two months before the departure date. The setup fee guarantees your delegation's space on our calendar and is nonrefundable. However, in the case of low recruitment this set up fee may be transferred to another date (if available) or one of our open Food Sovereignty Tours.
4. Mail this form to: Food First, Food Sovereignty Tours, 398 60th St. Oakland, CA 94618 or scan and email both sides to foodsovtours@foodfirst.org. After receipt of your group's application and setup fee, the Food Sovereignty Tours Coordinator will mail or email you a contract with your confirmed dates.
